This six-week, summer program offers daily activities for Town of North Hempstead residents with developmental disabilities, including arts and leisure, music appreciation, cooking, an outdoor pool, outdoor recreation, and more. The program also brings participants on weekly recreational outings, such as Bayville Adventure Park, the Nassau Country Fair, Eisenhower Park, Queens Zoo, Tanger Outlets, along with local bowling alleys, shopping malls and movie theaters.

This **FREE** and unique Summer program operates **5 days a week, 9:00am-3:00pm, Tuesday through Saturday**, and provides the opportunity for participants to fully explore their communities through a range of social, educational, and recreational activities. The program's home base is Clinton G. Martin Park, conveniently located at New Hyde Park Road & Marcus Avenue in New Hyde Park. The program is offered in full-day and half-day formats.
